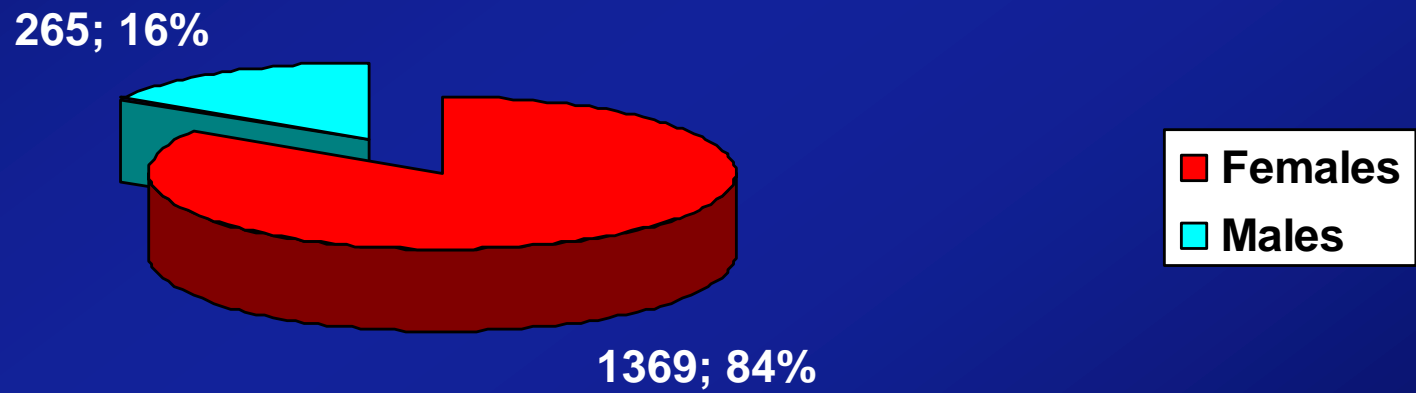

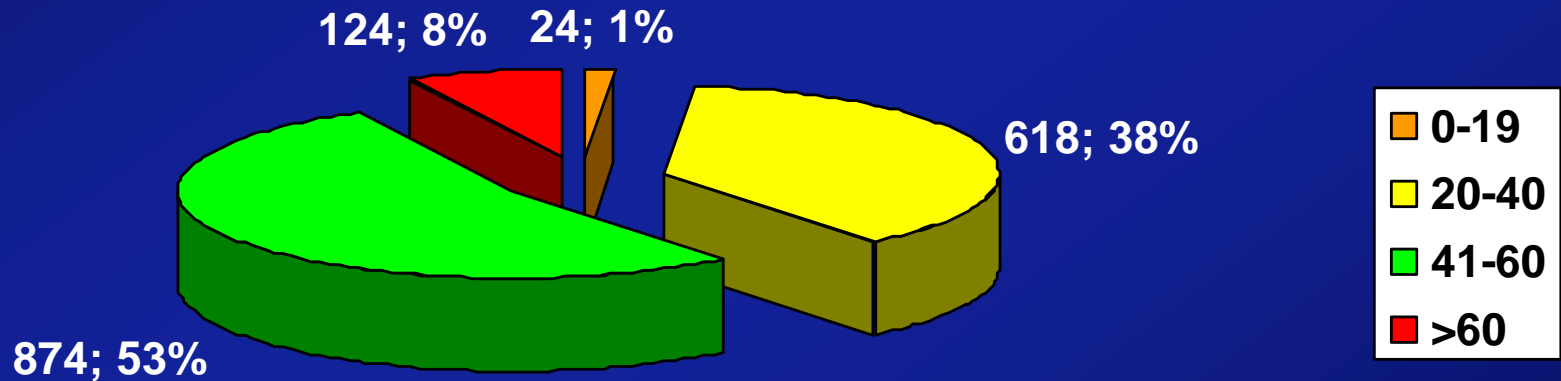

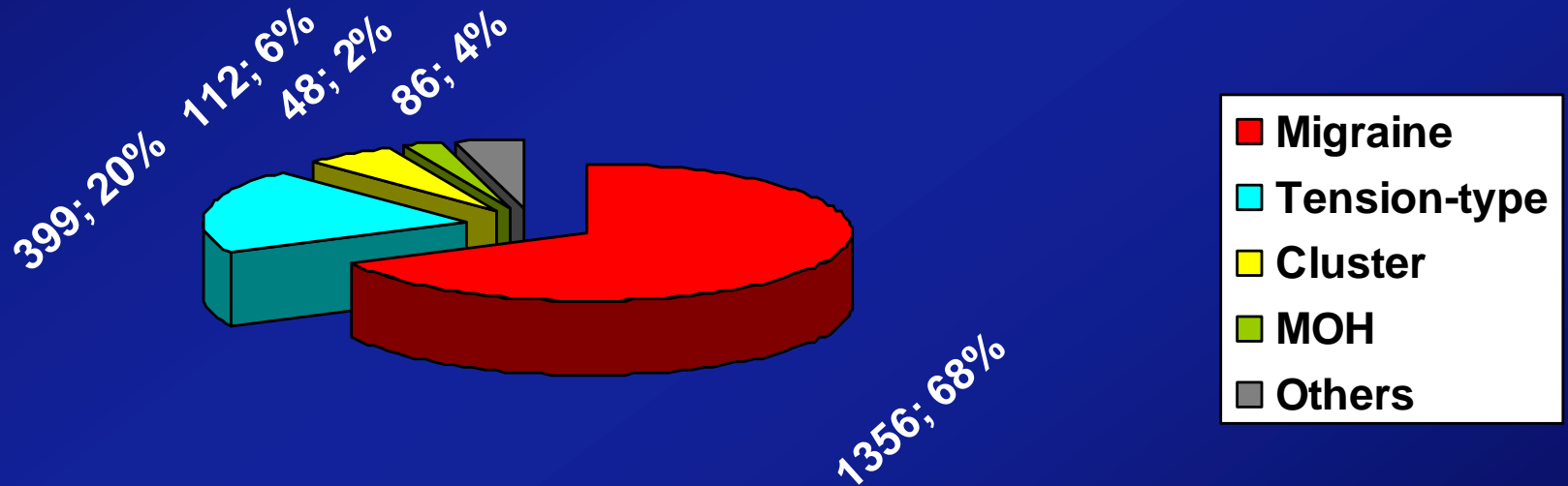
Gender



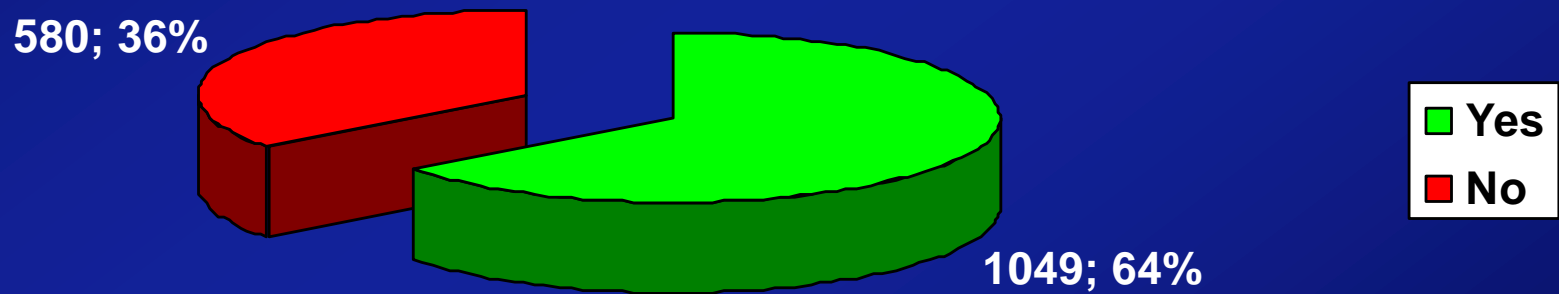
Age distribution



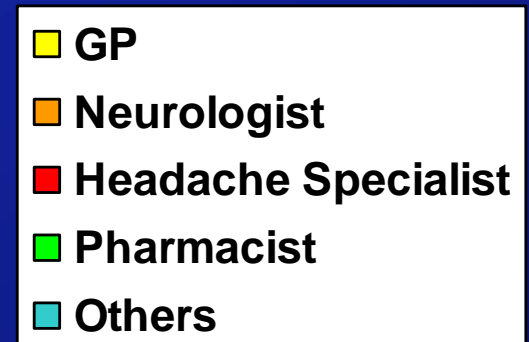
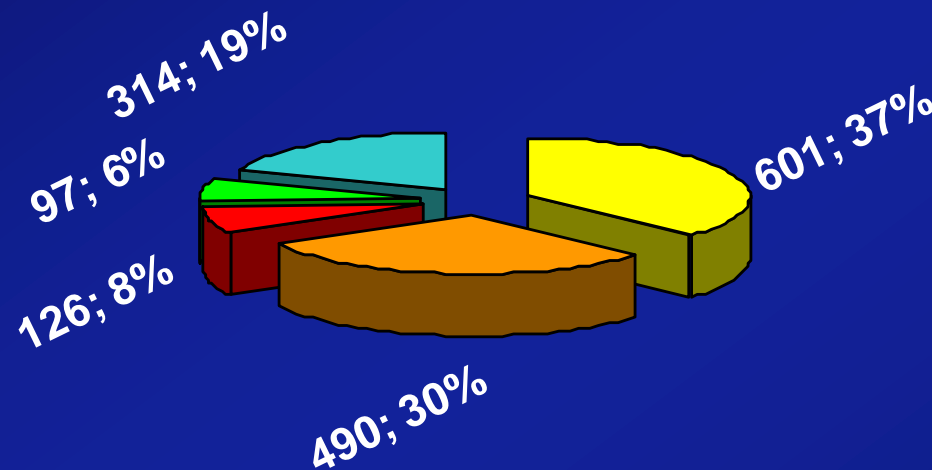
Which kind of headache do you suffer from?



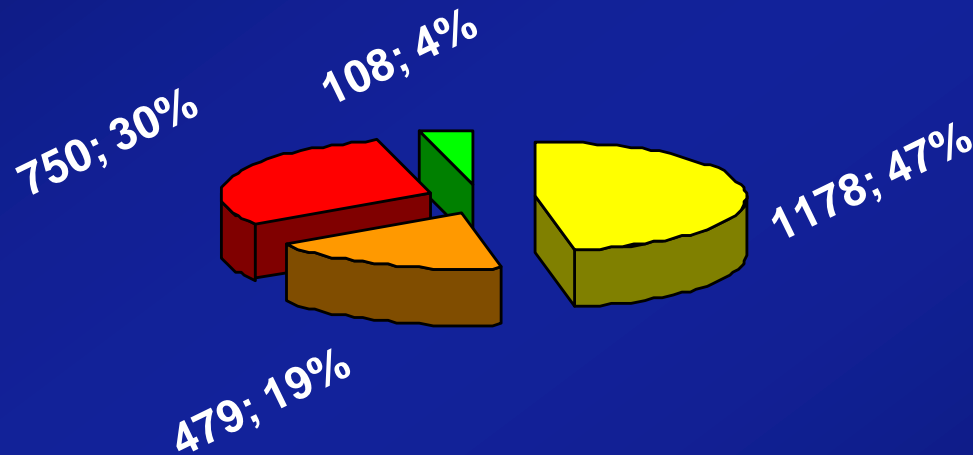
Do you regularly see a health professional for treatment?

Do you use any of the following?

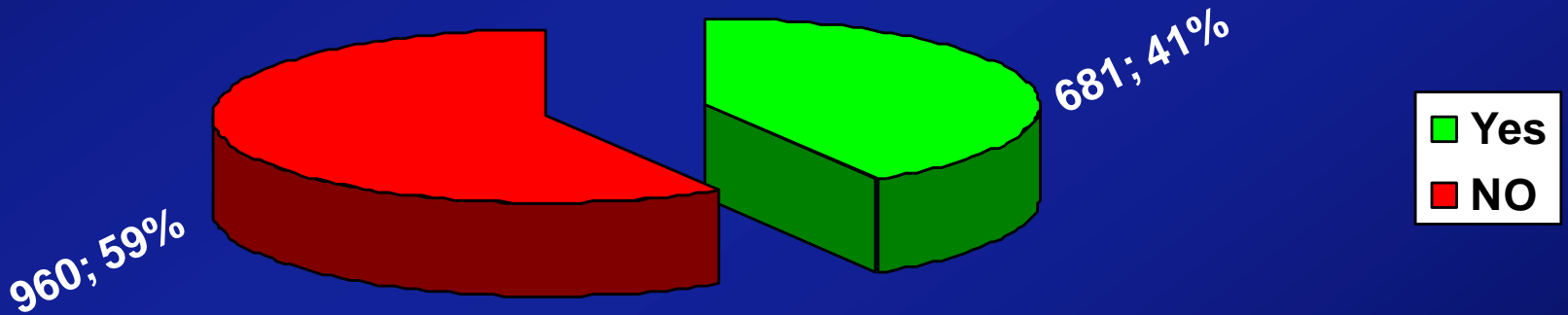

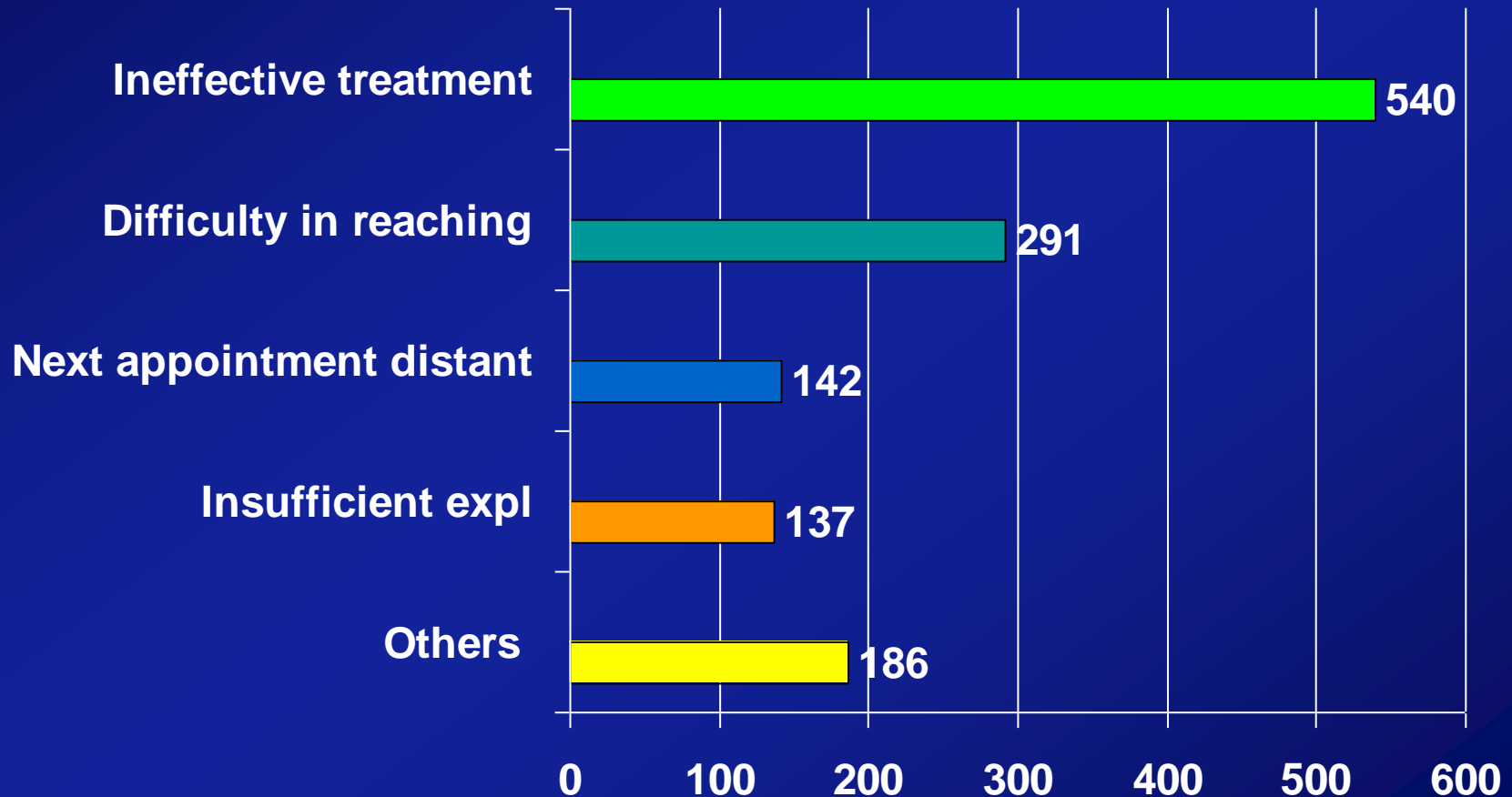
If you are using Prophylaxis – what length of time elapsed between first consultation with a Health Professional and being prescribed preventative medication?

Mean = 8.1 years

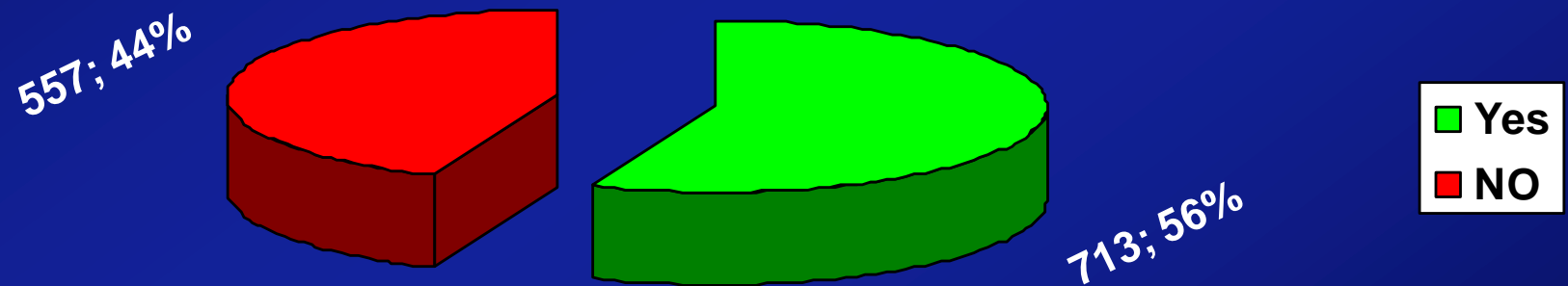
Are you satisfied with the management and treatment of your condition?
